The health and safety of our patients, their families, and our staff remains our top priority. As a result, St. Joseph's Health is restricting visitation across all of its hospitals, nursing and rehabilitation facilities. These changes take effect on Thursday, December 3.

NEW VISITOR POLICY RESTRICTIONS ARE:

- St. Joseph's University Medical Center, Paterson: No visitors
- St. Joseph's Wayne Medical Center, Wayne: No visitors
- St. Joseph's Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center, Cedar Grove: No visitors
- Outpatient/Physician Practices – No visitors

VISITATION EXCEPTIONS MAY BE MADE IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS, INCLUDING:

- End of Life Compassion Visit - One visitor, brief visit
- St. Joseph's Children's Hospital - One visitor
- Ambulatory Care/Same Day Surgery - One visitor
- Maternity/Labor and Delivery - One visitor
- Developmental and Cognitive Disabled – One visitor
- For Patients that are Being Discharged – One visitor at discharge for bedside instruction

FOR ALL VISITORS

- All visitors must have their ID ready to help expedite the process.
- Once a visitor is approved, they will undergo a temperature screening.
- No children under 18 are allowed to visit patients.
- Adhere to social distancing guidelines and wear a mask at all times.
- Phone and video calls to patients are welcome and encouraged.
