Patient Identification is one of the most critical steps in patient safety. This is an active process for you and the patient. Verify Patient identification with every interaction: before every medication administration event, procedure, lab, or diagnostic work. The two identifiers are:

> 1) Patient Name 2) Patient Date of Birth

ASK DON'T TELL : Refrain from "telling" people their information, which usually solicits a nod or one word answer that does not provide clarifying information.

ASK patients to state their name and date of birth

ALLERGY FALL RISK

Verify against their wrist band and order/requisition form- SCAN!

Apply high-visibility, colored alert bracelets for patient conditions:

Language interpretation can be facilitated with the CyraCom Phone Lines.

Did you determine a mismatch between what the patient said and what is written in the record? If so, **GOOD CATCH!** Take steps to correct the record to ensure safety in future patient encounters. Notify all team members of the change and contact Patient Access/Registration (Bed Management on off hours) to verify and correct the medical record.
