Face Covering vs. Face Mask vs. Respirator

 <p>Cloth Face Coverings may be worn by visitors, but are not appropriate for employee use within the facility</p>	 <p>FDA approved Medical/Surgical face masks must be worn by all staff in patient facing areas unless a higher level of protection is required</p>	 <p>SJH provides the required mask to employees</p> <p>The respiratory protection program fit tests identified personnel requiring respirators for airborne or Covid 19 related assignments</p>
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EYE PROTECTION + MASKING

Unless physical barriers are present (ie plexiglass), **Eye Protection**, in addition to **Masking**, is required in all patient facing areas.
 *Your personal reading/distance glasses are not considered eye protection.
